The Cumberland County Piecemakers Quilt Guild will hold their 5th biennial Mountain Memories Quilt Show Friday, and Saturday, June 19 & 20. The event is at the Community Complex and is held in conjunction with Depot Days. 200 quilts will be on display in several different categories. Viewers will decide the ribbon winners in each category by picking their favorites. There will be quilting demonstrations and lectures on the hour throughout both days. The show will also have vendors and lots and lots of door prizes. This year's show will feature a special appearance by Marsha Radtke, local quilter and book author. Marsha's quilt "The Pastor's Attic" won the Best of Show at the 2007 show. She wrote a book about how she found the 1850s in her pastor's attic and replicated the patterns. Her book has all the patterns from that antique quilt.
